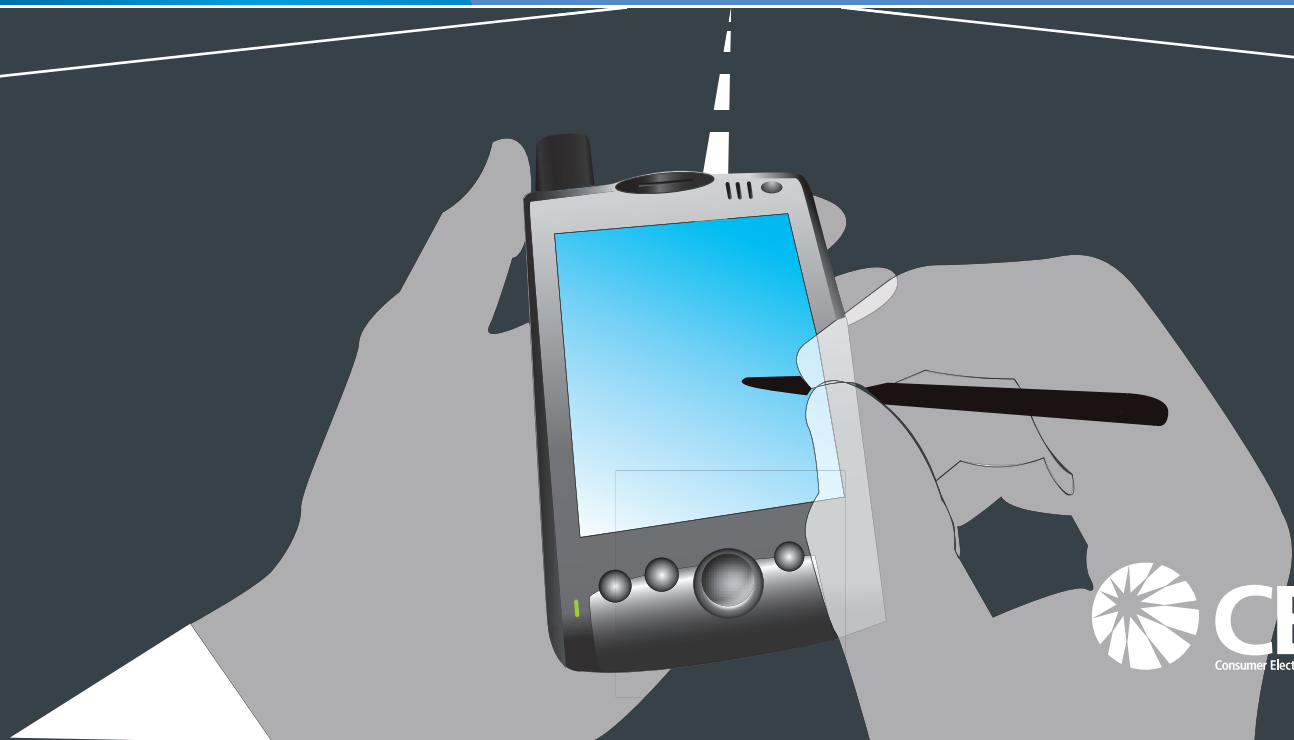




# ROAD WARRIOR GUIDE TO ACCESSORIES

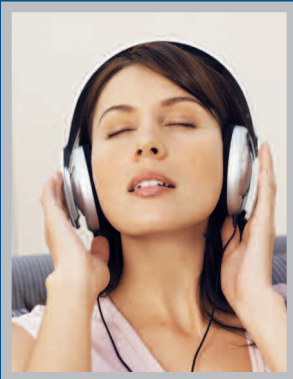


## *Make the Most of Your Time at the Airport*
